Project **Speak out loudly!** involves a group of 18 young people (between 16 and 25 years) from two countries: Poland and Turkey. Each of the organizations will be represented by 8 participants and 1 leader. Today, young people have strong impression that they are not able to influence reality around them. Many of them think that their voice is not hearable, even in case of concerning their problems. Regarding this, the main theme of the youth exchange will be a **civic journalism** as a tool which can be used to pay attention to the important problems. You will get to know **what civic means** and will explore all aspects of it. European citizenship will be strongly underlined as a way for better solutions of the problems. Thanks to the project you will understand a belief that journalism has an obligation to public life – an obligation that goes beyond just telling the news or unloading lots of facts. This way you will start perceive journalism as a affecting the way public life goes. You will get to know different genres of journalism regarding the topic, the methods, forms and styles. The main objective of the exchange is to **equip young people with tools which let express themselves and share their thoughts and opinions.**

By tools we can understand writing skills, knowledge about writing rules, including ethic. Main working methods will be informal workshops including discussions, group work, meetings with an expert and local community, and the usage of technical equipment – computers, cameras etc. In addition, the identification of a common problem will intensify communication between young people from different countries and promote their active citizenship. The

most and physical effect of the project will be a joint publication a magazine, a blog or facebook page. Apart from that it will be also acquired skills which are going to be developed in the future.



TRAVEL REIMBRUISMENT

Travel expenses will be reimbursed during the exchange on following conditions:

- (1) Participant has provided all the bills, invoices, tickets and boarding passes.
- (2) Participant has used cheapest means of transportation (2nd class tickets).
- (3) Participant has participated in scheduled activities.
